REACH-regulation 1907/2006

Dear Sir and Madam

Since June 1, 2007, the REACH regulation (EC 1907/2006) came into force.

This European regulation is forcing all manufacturers, importers, distributors and users of chemical substances to carry out the registration of these substances if they are produced in quantities > 1 ton.

Please note the deadlines of pre-registration.

Chemical substances which are not registered, although a registration is required, may no longer put into commercial EU-market from 2009 in accordance with the REACH regulation.

We expect our suppliers that the chemical substances, which we refer will be handled accordingly the REACH Regulation.

If on the basis of the REACH Regulation certain substances no longer can be supplied, I ask for immediate notification.

The company Rudolf Uhlen GmbH presents its high-quality health and safety articles for the face and eye protection, made of materials that do not meet the obligation to register:

- Visors made of polycarbonate polymers and cellulose acetate
- Head gears with browguards of polypropylene
- Carriers of aluminium and various standard parts
- Paints, thinners and adhesives are used consumed in small quantities <200 Kg / a.

I hope that our accountability towards you have met with this reference to the materials which are used in our company.
